Most stores in the area will remain open until 9 P.M. from December 19, through December 23. On Christmas Eve they will close at six.

Most stores except groceries will remain closed on the Saturday following Christmas and New Year's.

Sixty merchants attended the meetings, which saw the newly formed organization lay down plans for the election of permanent officers and a program for the coming year.

Principal items of business to be taken up by the group for the coming year will be uniform closing hours, the establishment of a credit bureau, and the election of officers, which will take place after the first of the year.
