Livestock Marketing Conference Slated at Oregon State College

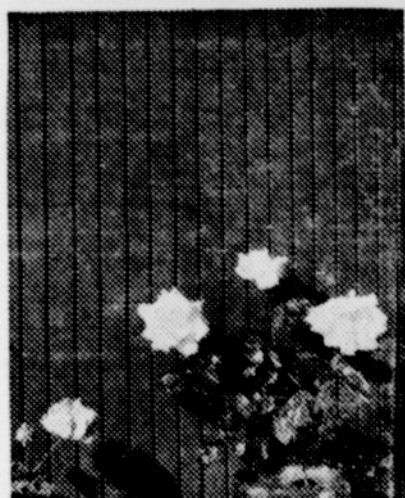
Oregon people should get a better understanding of all factors involved in livestock and meat marketing by attending the conference to be held at Oregon State college Jan. 6 and 7, according to Ken Priest, Curry County extension agent. He said current conditions in the industry are focusing attention on the need for taking a look at livestock and meat from the animal to the table. Oregon State college extends on service is sponsoring the conference in which producers, sellers, packers and wholesalers, retailers, labor groups and consumers will be taking part. Changes that have developed in marketing over the years have brought on the conference, according to Frank L. Ballard, associate director of Oregon State college extension service.

The immediate reasons for holding it now, he said, are the recent breaks in livestock prices, record number of cattle in the U.S. position in the cattle cycle, low print in hog cycle, low lamb prices despite low sheep numbers and the cost price squeeze confronting the livestock producer. Priest said the conference is aimed at developing better understanding among the people who handle livestock and meat products.

Recommendations that will guard the industry's future in Oregon may come out of the meeting in January. The six groups taking part have already given their ideas of some of the interesting problems and questions as they see them. Their reports are to be prepared from views expressed at their preliminary meetings. However, Priest emphasized that other opinions may be expressed during the January conference. He invites both individuals and organizations to take part and express their views.

Unanimous support to the reappraisal program for Curry county was given by the Curry County Livestock Association at the annual meeting, held in the courthouse in Gold Beach on Dec. 4. Other recommendations approved were a continuation of the present predatory animal control program, a more intensified weed control program, and a continuation of the association's livestock theft reward of \$500.

Also recommended was a reward of \$100 to be paid for the arrest and conviction of anyone spotlighting or night-hunting. Attendance at the livestock marketing conference to be held in Corvallis on Jan. 6 and 7 was assured by the membership.
