Load Violations

Bring Heavy Fines

Eldon E. Harroun of Brookings was assessed fines totalling \$400 plus costs, after pleading guilty to three charges of improper loading of a truck before Justice Charles S. Schaal, Monday.

Harroun was fined \$380 for being 7,600 pounds overweight, and was fined \$10 each on counts of having an overlength load, and having insufficient binders. Costs totalled \$13.50.

Harroun had originally pleaded not guilty, and had asked for a jury trial, but changed his plea Monday. The overload fine was assessed at the normal rate of five cents per pound of overload.

Hay Good For Hogs, Specialist States

Hay has long been one of the staple feeds for workstock and cattle and it's just as good for hogs, says John Landers, extension animal husbandry specialist at Oregon State college. This is important when there's not enough green feed for brood sows in the winter, he continues.

Hog growers who don't have available green grazing for their brood sows can very successfully use a little alfalfa hay to add protein and vitamins to rations. The specialist recommends placing the hay in a rack and feeding it free choice.

Hogs probably won't eat more than a pound of hay each day, Landers explains. But the little they do eat will go a long way toward turning them into quality market animals.
