J. E. Burbach, janitor at the school, was knocked across the room when the bolt shattered the 11 windows along the face of the building.

Rain and wind still continued after the electrical storm, and Coos-Curry was hard put to keep service on. Service from the north was interrupted at Pistol river and had not yet been repaired Wednesday. Service in Brookings was being taken from Copco, but there were numerous interruptions in scattered areas, as winds took down wires and damaged transformer fuses let go.

Roads were still open Wednesday afternoon, but deteriorating. There was a little water on the highway between Crescent City and Brookings, and there was danger that other roads might be closed if the rains and winds continued.
