**Lumber Industry Figures Given**

Harris E. Smith, secretary of West Coast Lumbermen's Association, today released production, order and shipment figures for the Douglas fir industry.

The statistical picture of the industry is complete through March and compares output, sales and shipments with the same period for last year.

The weekly average of West Coast lumber production in March was 211,685,000 b.f. or 110.1% of the 1949-1953 average. Orders averaged 224,565,000 b.f.; Shipments 222,307,000 b.f.; Weekly averages for February were: Production 199,235,000 b.f.; 103.6% of the 1949-1953 average; Orders 215,754,000 b.f.; Shipments 196,355,000 b.f.

Three months of 1954 cumulative production 2,540,689,000 b.f.; Three months of 1953 2,722,311,000 b.f.; Three months of 1952, 2,489,029,000 b.f.

Orders for three months of 1954 breakdown as follows: Rail & Truck 1,898,029,000 b.f.; Domestic Cargo 553,779,000 b.f.; Exports 149,942,000 b.f.; Local 107,537,000 b.f.

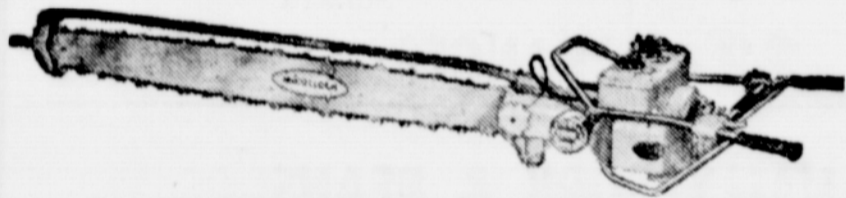

**DreamCamp Ready For Crippled Kids By July First**

Camp Easter Seal, Oregon's only summer camp for crippled children, tentatively plans to receive its first group of young campers July 1st, Howard Feast, executive director of the Oregon Society for Crippled Children and Adults, the Easter Seal Society, has announced.

"A lot of our planning is based on the success of the current Easter Seal sale," Feast stated, "and so far it looks like we're going to be in a position to get things under way."

Camp Easter Seal is an 80-acre tract on North lake of Ten-Mile lake, near Reedsport. It is accessible only by water and the society has been given a 28-foot cruiser with which to transport the youngsters to the camp, Feast said.

Labor unions, service organizations, industries, business houses and women's organizations from Coos and Douglas counties have contributed materials, labor and money to the camp and work has been under way for several months looking towards its opening.

Feast said the present plan is to accommodate from 15 to 20 children every 10 days, from July 1 to Sept. 1. A permanent-type dormitory facility, adequate for the housing of physically handicapped children, is being readied and an administration building for the staff is complete.

The camp's staff will include a physical therapist and experienced camp leaders. The children, Feast said, will be given outdoor camp opportunities to the limits of their physical ability. There will be boating, fishing and crafts.

Camp Easter Seal will be open to physically handicapped children from all parts of the state.
