

Portland Firm Gets Brookings Street Contract

K. F. Jacobsen and Co., Inc., of Portland was low bidder on the paving of Pacific and Hillside Avenues in Brookings, according to word released by State Highway Commission.

Jacobsen's bid was \$14,175.00. The bid was referred to the state engineer for awarding.

Preliminary grading and the construction of curbs on the two streets has been virtually completed by Leroy Weideman, local contractor. Jacobsen and Co. are expected to begin their contract soon.

Two other Curry County contracts were awarded at the Commission's meeting. A contract to build the Rock Point viaduct on Highway 101 south of Port Orford was awarded to Wall, Bartram and Sanford of Junction City for \$120,465.00. And Mark Smith and Company of Klamath Falls received the contract to fence the new highway's right-of-way from 8 miles south of Port Orford to ten miles north of Gold Beach for \$19,580.00.
