May 29th and 30th, 1954

RULES

1. Anyone interested in raising flowers, shrubs etc or using them to the best advantages in the home, whether a member of the club or not, is invited to enter exhibits.
2. Entries will be registered from 7:30 to 10:00 A. M., on Saturday, May 29th.
3. Awards shall be: Blue Ribbon for 1st; Red for 2nd; White for 3rd; Green for Honorable mention. Only one in each class, according to the Standard System of Judging. (Judges will be from out of town.)
4. Sweepstakes Prizes will be awarded to the winner of the greatest number of Blue ribbons in Horticulture classes. Also, in Artistic Arrangement class.
5. Only one entry in each division or subdivision may be made by an exhibitor.
6. No state Conservation material is to be included in any exhibit.
7. All entries in Horticultural classes MUST BE GROWN by exhibitor.
8. Flowers and foliage in Arrangement classes NEED NOT BE GROWN by exhibitor.
9. Horticultural specimens must be correctly labeled Tags and containers furnished by committee.
10. Each exhibitor will furnish containers, marked with owners name on the bottom for all artistic arrangements.
11. All measurements refer to COMBINED HEIGHT of CONTAINER and MATERIALS.
12. Container must be called for at 5 p. m. on May 30th. Second morning of show open from 10:00 a. m. to 12:00 for photographers.

ARRANGEMENTS

To be staged 40 inches from floor unless otherwise specified

CLASS 1. a—Arrangements featuring color. One color must predominate. To measure not more than 30" in height or width.

b—Same as shown with accessories.

CLASS 2. a—Arrangement suitable for coffee table. To be staged 18" from floor.

b—Same as above with accessories.

CLASS 3. a—Arrangement for dining room table. Not over 18" high.

b—Same as above with accessories

CLASS 4—a—Arrangement for buffet. To be viewed from one side only.

b—Same as above with accessories.

CLASS 5—"Congratulations" Bed-side table arrangement for new mother.

May have accessories

CLASS 6—"Tall and Handsome". Arrangement in pillow vase or urn etc

CLASS 7—"Twosome" Twin or companion vases—not necessarily identical.

CLASS 8—Arrangement featuring Club Flower (Azalea)

a—Those who have won ribbons in any show.

b—Those who have never won a ribbon or exhibited before.
