NOTICE OF SCHOOL ELECTION UPON QUESTION OF INCREASING TAX LEVY OVER AMOUNT LIMITED BY SECTION 11, ARTICLE XI, STATE CONSTITUTION

Notice is hereby given that an election will be held in School District No. 17C of Curry County, State of Oregon, at School House June 21, 1954, at 8 o'clock P. M. in said district, for the purpose of submitting to the legal voters of said district the question of increasing the tax levy for the year 1954 over the amount limited by section 11, article XI, of the Constitution of Oregon.

The reasons for increasing such levy are:

1. Increased cost of operating additional High School Building, lockers and bleachers for the new building.

2. 4½ additional Elementary teachers; 1 additional High School teacher.

3. Increased operational costs. The amount of tax, in excess of the 6% limitation, proposed to be levied for said year is \$76,458.99.

Coquille Chamber Plans Use For Curry County Highway 101 Funds

The Coquille Chamber of Commerce is making plans for a drive to improve Highway 42, which runs from Coquille to Highway 99, near Roseburg, according to a story in the Sunday Oregonian.

And the drive is being built around hopes that the funds originally intended for the improvement of Highway 101 in Curry County will be withdrawn.

The Oregonian story said that the Coquille Chamber was inviting representatives from Grants Pass, Myrtle Point, Bandon and Coos County to study the proposed road.

Clarence Osika, Secretary of the Coquille Chamber was quoted in the Oregonian story as saying that he had heard the state Highway Commission was contemplating the withdrawal of funds for the improvement of Highway 101 in Curry County because of what the Highway Commission consid-
