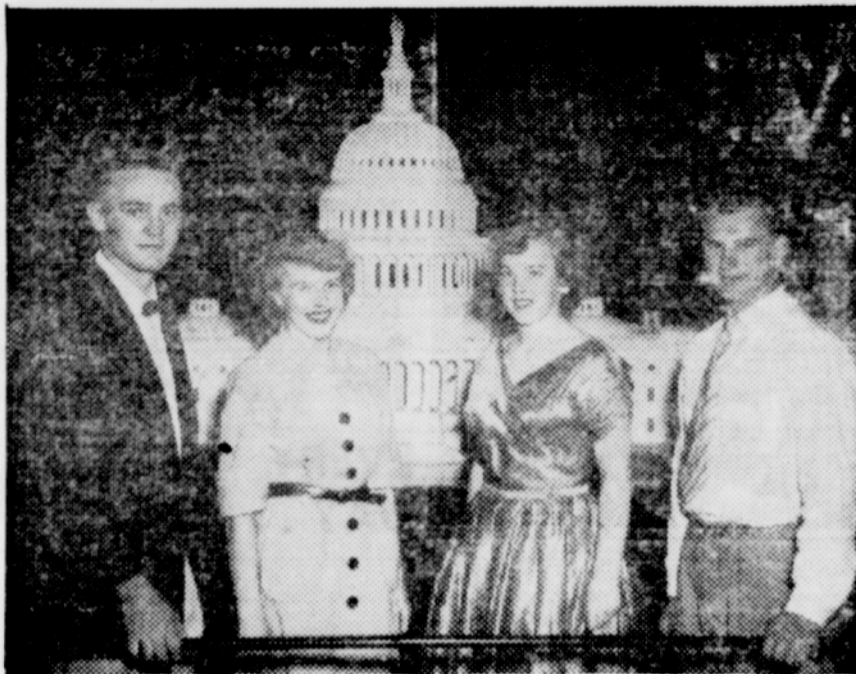


**Oregon 4-H Members to Visit Capitol**

County Agent**

There will be another work day  
at the County Fair grounds this  
Sunday. A pot-luck dinner is sched-  
uled for noon. Come and bring  
your hammer, saw, anything else  
you can manipulate.

Can you tell a T-bone from a  
porterhouse steak?— a top from  
a bottom round? Can you tell  
a Utility cut from a choice grade?  
Most meat dealers can't.

Businessmen, farmers and home-  
makers missed an average of 9  
out of 12 points on a meat iden-  
tification and grading quiz held  
recently near Portland. This was  
set up as a trial demonstration  
of meat identifications, grading,  
cutting and preparation which will  
be offered to all counties this  
fall and winter.

Present plans may include this  
demonstration at the Western  
Oregon Livestock Associations  
Annual Conference to be held in  
Gold Beach on November 4, 5  
and 6.

Home gardeners should look into  
the possible use of 2, 4-D. S. a  
recent chemical weed control  
measure sold under the trade  
name of "Crag-Herbicide".

This material prevents broad-  
leaved and grass weeds before  
they become a problem by killing  
the weed seeds before they germi-  
nate.

Crag-Herbicide can be sprayed

directly on many established  
plants without injury because it  
is not a weed killer until coming  
incontact with moist soil. Be cer-  
tain to follow the manufacturers  
directions.

Another weed killer of interest  
is Polybor-Chlorate. This ma-  
terial is non-selective and is toxic  
to all vegetation. Polybor-Chlorate  
can be used effectively on brick  
walks, patios and driveways with  
excellent results.
