

### Merchants Swamp Beavers 10 to 0

The law of averages finally caught up with the Brookings Beavers in their annual series with the Crescent City Merchants. The Beavers had won 7 straight, starting with the 1952 season, but the "worm turned" last Saturday on the Crescent City diamond as the Merchants poured it onto Brookings by a 10 to 0 score.

Manager George Yamor pitched the shut-out for Crescent City, allowing Brookings only 7 hits and leaving 12 runners on the bases. Tony Troncale pitched the first 4 innings for the Beavers and although he allowed 4 runs on 5 hits, none of the runs were classified as "earned", 6 errors contributing to the scoring. Bob Astin handled the mound duties the

last 4 innings, his first pitching start since injury to his hand at Coquille early in the season, and while giving up 4 hits and 6 runs, errors were responsible for all but one tally. Astin was somewhat wild but gave evidence that he may be of considerable help to Beaver pitching during the balance of the season.

Medford's Cheney studs lost both games to Drain the past week-end and thereby boosted the idle Beavers into 4th place in league standings. The Studs come to Brookings this coming Sunday for a one o'clock double-header, the final home games for Brookings.

A twin victory would assure the Beavers a definite 4th place finish and a spot in the post-season playoffs, while a split would leave the standings undecided pending the outcome of Medford's 2 postponed games with Coquille to be played August 15th.
