

BEAVERS SPLIT WITH STUDS

The Brookings Beavers divided a Southern Oregon league doubleheader with Medford's Cheney Studs here Sunday, taking the opener 5 to 4 and then dropping the nightcap 5 to 2.

The split coupled with the Grants Pass Cavemen's double defeat at Drain placed Brookings in a tie for 3rd place and a definite spot in the league's playoff series to start August 21st.

The first game was a "nip and tuck" affair and sustained fan interest until the last Cheney Stud was retired in the top of the 9th.

Manager and shortstop Bob Selsor made his first mound start of the season for the Beavers and although somewhat wild, pitched a good game, allowing only 5 hits.

The Studs scored in the first inning as Selsor forced in a run on a walk, a single and two batters hit by pitched balls. The Beavers evened the score with a tally in the 3rd on hits by Tony Troncale and Jim Barrett but the Studs again took a 1 run lead in the 5th on a walk to Hal Zucher and Terry Maddox's tripple to left.

Brookings then countered with 3 runs in their last half on a single by Lee Goodin, a double by Barrett, Cliff Girod's three-bagger and Selsor's sacrifice fly. The Beavers put over what proved to be the winning run in the 6th on doubles by McLean and Goodin. Medford tallied 2 unearned runs in the 7th on a walk, a single and 2 Beaver errors.

Lefty Jim Lehl started the 2nd game for Brookings and the Studs

opened up on him by scoring 3 unearned runs on a combination of walks, 2 hits and 2 Beaver errors. Lehl then settled down and pitched 4 scoreless innings. The Studs however managed two more unearned runs in the 6th on 2 singles and two additional fielding miscues.

Brookings was able to dent the plate only in the 2nd when Lloyd Hart walked Lehl and Barrett and Cliff Girod scored both with a double.

Although the league season ended Sunday, the start of Play-offs have been postponed until the week-end of the 21st, pending the outcome of two rained-out games between Medford and Coquille. The Beavers have been unable to book a game for the open date of August 15th and will mark time by the usual practice sessions on Tuesday and Thursday evenings.
