

DEL NORTE COUNTY FAIR TO OPEN FRIDAY AFTERNOON AT CRESCENT

Final touches will be put on today for the opening of the Del Norte county fair at the fairgrounds in Crescent City for its three day run on August 20, 21, and 22.

The three days have been jam-packed with entertainment and sightseeing for fair visitors. The main pavilion will house five feature exhibits, two one family farm exhibits and a host of individual exhibits in the floriculture, home economics, horticulture, and agriculture classes.

The 4-Hers of Del Norte county for the first time have been allotted an entire pavilion to themselves where there will be feature booth exhibits of the agriculture, sewing, cooking, and electricity groups as well as numerous individual competitive exhibits. The animal husbandry of the 4-H members will also be on exhibit at the 4-H judging pen.

On Sunday for the first time will be held a 4-H livestock auction at the livestock judging ring, beginning at 11 a. m. On Saturday at the midway stage, 4-H members from throughout the county will put on demonstrations of farm problems and farm knowledge.

Elsewhere in the fair grounds, Bozo the Clown will entertain daily as will a score of professional entertainers at the grandstand pavilion stage. Horse shows are scheduled daily and horse races are scheduled for 1 p. m. on Saturday and Sunday.

Friday evening will mark a big night for some Del Norte girl who will be crowned Del Norte's Maid of California, will reign over the county fair and then go to Sacramento on August 28 to compete in the Maid of California contest at the California state fair.

Fourteen girls have been entered in the local contest and they will make their bow to the public Friday evening at 8 p. m. when they are escorted onto the grandstand pavilion stage.

Judges have been selected by the fair management.

As in the past, a midway will be maintained by community organizations. All kinds of carnival games and food concessions will be found in the midway. Bozo the clown will entertain at the midway stage where on Friday, Kids Day, August 20, there will be many special events including pie eating contests and various kinds or races.

On Saturday, Del Norte granges will be honored for their annual participation in the Del Norte county fair. All of the

county's four granges, Klamath Valley, Crescent Redwood, Lake Earl and Del Norte Pomona grange have put in feature exhibits in the fair. Grangers ilion.

A hobbies and crafts building will be open for the first time this year under the direction of Lennis Fike. Every kind of hobby from rock-collecting to stamp collecting will be on display.
