**STATE'S SHARE IN MONEY BILL; \$397 MILLION**

The state of Oregon's share in the recently-passed 1955 national appropriations bill comes to \$397,169,025, according to the Northwest office of the National Association of Manufacturers at Portland.

This is some \$69,000,000 less than the 1954 appropriations bill cost the state taxpayers, the NAM stated.

The national money bill totals \$54,288,093,410 for the year June, 1954, to June, 1955. This is \$6.9 billion less than the fiscal 1954 amount.

Largest item on the bill again this year is defense; \$28,800,135,486, of which Oregonians must

contribute about \$316,801,380.

Some \$6.8 billion must be paid by the government this year in interest on the near-\$275 billion national debt. Here, Oregon's share is \$74,800,000, the NAM pointed out.

"It is distressing to note that the amount budgeted for debt interest far exceeds the amount set for veterans' affairs, public housing, agriculture, post office, mutual security program, or most of the cabinet departments," the NAM stated.

The independent offices bill (veterans, housing, etc.) this year amounts to \$6,651,770,063; of this, Oregon's share is \$62,169,470.

"Considering the fact that it takes on the average of \$12,000 to create a new job in industry today, the \$69 million reduction for the state from the 1954 money bill could mean the potential creation of some 5,750 new jobs in the state.

"With the state's population growing at the rate of almost a thousand a week, such savings to the taxpayers are necessary to allow for investment in new and expanded industry," the NAM added.

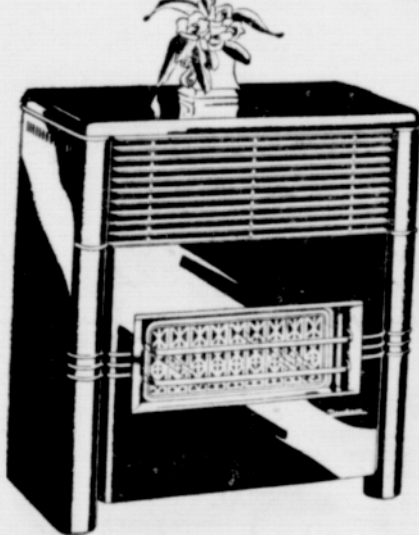
