Teachers Needed In State Schools

With the opening of schools throughout the state, the Oregon Education Association is daily receiving urgent calls for additional teachers from school districts where enrollments have exceeded previous estimates. School authorities believe that this year there will be over 700 additional teachers and 20,000 more children than last year in Oregon schools.

"Oregon high schools are now indicating an acute need for young women teachers who are trained for teaching combinations in girls Physical Education, Home Economics, English, and commercial subjects," according

to Marcia Mills. As director of the nation's largest education association placement bureau, Mrs. Mills reveals other trends in teacher supply and demand which will effect many Oregon schools. One of the more prominent of these is a growing need for young men teachers in the elementary schools. Primary teachers remain in great demand.

During this opening week of school she has received many calls from Oregon school districts. One school superintendent pleaded, "Mrs. Mills, the Oregon Education association has to find me a band director. I'm going to look and feel awfully funny out marching those kids around." Another male principal asked, "How do you think I'll look in an apron teaching home economics. Don't say it, but if we don't get a teacher, that's what it'll be."

Recently a promising young male elementary teacher was en route to a prospective teaching position. On his way he was met by an administrator who hired him on the spot. Others could also have used his services.

Should enrollments exceed the above estimates the problems of teacher supply will be further compounded. The future remains far from promising, despite the forward educational strides of recent years.

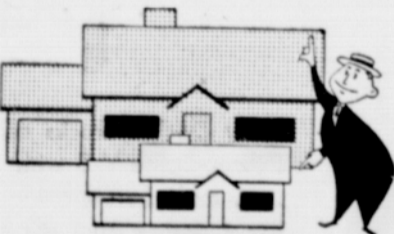
