Rotary Club Hears Highway Report

Arthur Knox reported to the Rotary club about the possibilities of the completion of highway 101 at their regular meeting. Knox and two other men, E. L. Morton, and Carl Ostenberg, made a trip to the highway commission under the sponsorship of the Chamber of Commerce.

The delegation had a short hearing with the commission in regard to rumors that highway 101 is not going to be completed because of the high condemnation verdicts rendered against the department.

According to Knox the highway commission still plans to complete the project before attempting anything else in this area, although the highway has been temporarily held up because of lack of funds.

Knox said that the commission said that it will cost an estimated \$15,000,000 to complete the highway from Brookings to Pistol River. A greater portion of the right of way from Brookings to Pistol River is now in the hands of the commission, but acquiring the right of way is still a problem.
