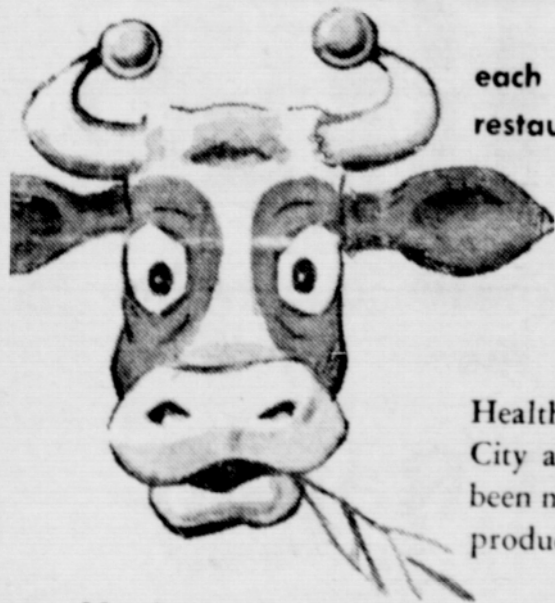

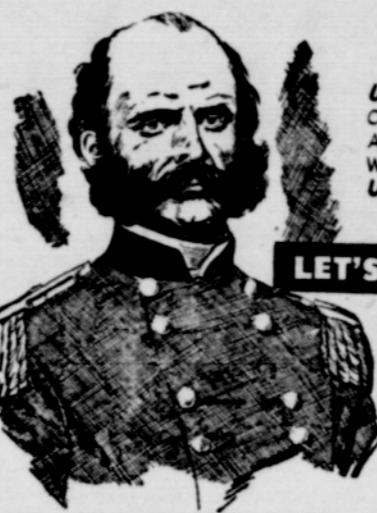

Local, National Republicans Slate Pow-Wows Friday

The political campaign records will be smashed next Friday, Republican National Precinct Day, it was announced by E. L. Morton, chairman of the Curry County Republican Central Committee.

Mr. Morton said Precinct Day will mark the largest national caucus in the 100-year history of the Republican Party, and that evening meetings will be addressed by President Eisenhower and Vice President Nixon over the largest political radio-TV network ever assembled.

Dawn-to-dusk pow-wows will be held all day Friday across the country to recruit thousands of new GOP precinct workers. Pow-wows will be conducted in homes,

school houses, at picnics, teas, barbecues, and other types of meetings. Congressional and local Republican candidates will spend the entire day visiting one pow-wow after another.

At night local party caucuses will be assembled for assignment of campaign tasks to precinct workers, and for group hearing and visiting of the President's and Vice President's addresses. The broadcast will originate from Denver.

Vice President Nixon, today advised all GOP County Chairmen that participation in Republican National Precinct Day "will help write a new chapter in the annals of American political history."

He called upon everyone interested in supporting President Eisenhower's program to "join our pow-wows and caucuses Friday to help plan our all-out campaign to win a Republican Congress in November."

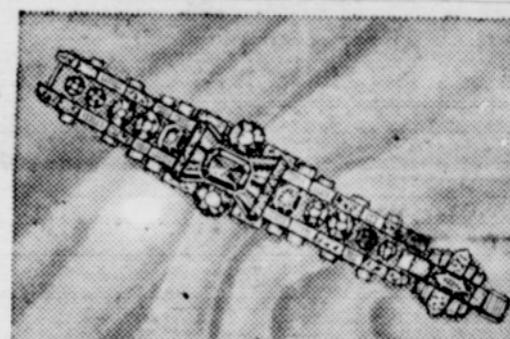

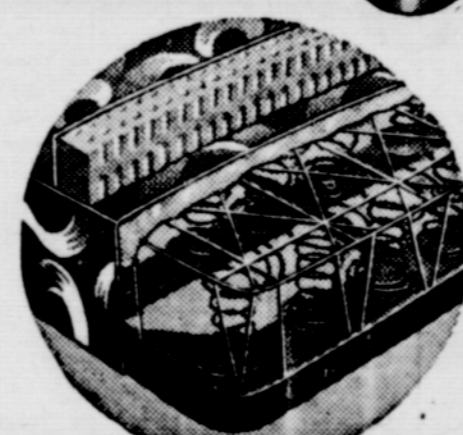
