NOTICE OF THE PROPOSED FORMATION OF THE HARBOR RURAL FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT CURRY COUNTY, OREGON.

BY ORDER OF THE COUNTY COURT OF CURRY COUNTY, STATE OF OREGON.

Notice is hereby given as follows:

1. A hearing on the petition before the County Court of Curry County, Oregon, to form or organize the hereinafter set forth territory into a rural fire protection district, to be known as The Harbor Rural Fire Protection District of Curry County, State of Oregon, shall be held on November 22nd, 1954, at the hour of 8 o'clock P. M. in the Council Chamber in the City of Brookings, Curry County, State of Oregon, in the City Hall, of said City of Brookings, Oregon.

2. That the boundaries of the aforesaid territory and contained in said petition are as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point marked by the North quarter of Section Four (4) Township Forty-one (41) South Range Thirteen (13) West, Willamette Meridian, Curry County, Oregon, thence Southerly on the center line of said Section Four (4), three-quarter (¾) miles, more or less, to the Northeast (NE) corner of Govt. Lot one (1) in said section Four (4);

Thence Easterly three-quarter (¾) mile, more or less, along the North Boundary Line of Govt. Lot Six (6), said Section Four (4), to the Northeast (NE) corner of said Govt. Lot Six (6);

Thence Southerly .475 miles, more or less, to an intersection with the North boundary line of Pedrioli Brother's ranch;

Thence Easterly along the North boundary line of said Pedrioli Brothers ranch to the South east (SE) corner of Govt. Lot One (1) in Section Nine (9);

Thence Southerly along the East Boundary line of said Section Nine (9) to the Southwest (SW) corner of Govt. Lot Four (4), Section Ten (10);

Thence Easterly .425 miles, more or less, to angle point no. 4, Govt. Lot Three (3), in said Section Ten (10);

Thence Southerly to the Southwest (SW) corner of Govt. Lot Two (2), said Section Ten (10);

Thence Easterly to the section corner common to sections Ten (10), Eleven (11), Fourteen (14) and Fifteen (15), Township Forty-one (41) South, Range Thirteen (13) West, Willamette Meridian,

Thence Southerly along the West boundary line of said Section Fourteen (14) to its intersection with the East boundary line of the Oregon Coast Highway;

Thence Southeasterly following said East boundary line of the Oregon Coast Highway to its intersection with the South boundary line of said Section Fourteen (14);

Thence Easterly along the said South boundary line of Section (14) to the South quarter (¼) corner of said Section Fourteen (14);

Thence South along the center line of Section Twenty-three (23) to the center of said Section Twenty-three (23);

Thence Easterly to the East quarter (¼) corner of said Section Twenty-three (23);

Thence Southerly along the East boundary line of said Section Twenty-three (23) to the section corner, common to Section Twenty-three (23), Twenty-four (24), Twenty-five (25), and Twenty-six (26), Township Forty-

one (41) South, Range Thirteen (13) West, Willamette Meridian; Thence Southerly along the East boundary line of said Section Twenty-six (26) to the Oregon-California State Line;

Thence Westerly along said Oregon-California State Line to an intersection with the mean high tide line of the Pacific Ocean;

Thence, disregarding any tidal action in the Winchuck River, Northwesterly along said mean high tide of the Pacific Ocean to its intersection with the North boundary line of Govt. Lot Three (3) Section Twenty-two (22);

Thence Easterly along the North boundary line of Govt. Lot Three (3) and Govt. Lot Four (4) Said Section Twenty-two and Lot 4A (4A) Section Twenty-three (23) to its intersection with the West boundary line of the Oregon Coast Highway;

Thence Northwesterly along said West boundary line of the Oregon Coast Highway to its intersection with the North boundary line of the Southeast Quarter (SE¼) of the Southeast Quarter (SW¼ of Section Fifteen (15);

Thence Westerly along the north boundary line of the Southeast Quarter (SE¼) of the Southeast Quarter (SE¼) and the Southwest Quarter (SW¼) of the Southeast Quarter (SE¼) and Govt. Lot Two (2), all in said Section Fifteen (15), to the mean high tide line of the Pacific Ocean;

Thence Northwesterly following said mean high tide line to its intersection with the thread of the Chetco River;

Thence Northerly following the thread of the stream or said Chetco River to its intersection with the North boundary line of Section Five (5);

Thence Easterly along the North boundary line of said Section Five (5) and Section Four (4) Township Forty-one (41) South, Range Thirteen (13) West, Willamette Meridian, to the point of beginning; excluding from said area, however, all property which is excluded by Section 478.010 O. R. S.

NOTICE OF ELECTION TO ESTABLISH NEW CITY TAX BASE

On November 2nd, 1954, in the City of Brookings, Curry County, Oregon, from 8:00 o'clock A. M. until 8:00 o'clock P. M. a city tax base election will be held at which the following proposition will be submitted to the legal voters of the City of Brookings, Oregon, for their approval or rejection.

ESTABLISHING NEW TAX BASE.

Shall the City of Brookings, Curry County, Oregon, increase its tax base from \$21,125.85 to \$29,250.00.

53—Yes 54—No.

This proposition, if adopted, will establish a new tax base for the City of Brookings, Oregon, for the purpose of applying the limitation on taxation set forth in section 11, Article XI, Oregon Constitution.

The present tax base is \$21,125.85, the new tax base if adopted will be \$29,250.00, and the new tax base base if adopted shall first apply to the levy for the fiscal year next following this election, which shall be the fiscal year commencing July 1, 1955.

The City and County precincts within the City of Brookings will have uniform boundaries and the same election boards. The Polling places in the City for the tax base election will be at the same places as provided by Curry County for the state-wide regular general election to be held on the same day, November 2, 1954, and to such places as the election boards may legally adjourn.

The City Council by ordinance has appointed the identical officers appointed by the Curry County, Oregon, for the state-wide regular general election, as the judges and clerks of the City tax base election to serve in each of the polling places in the respective precincts to which they are appointed by the County Court of Curry County, Oregon.
