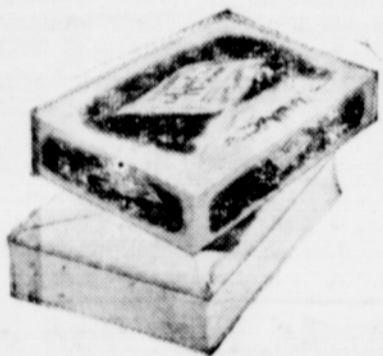

erty owners haven't paid for the work as yet, and the city voted to take action on January 1st against those still owing money.

The council discussed briefly the resolution presented by the Chamber of Commerce, which called for a general obligation bond which would enable the city to 1. obtain an adequate municipally owned domestic water supply. 2. Construct a badly needed sanitary sewage distribution system. 3. To take necessary steps for an adequate street surfacing program.

It was decided to study the resolution over more fully at a later date.

The council also had discussion on the sewer problem here, especially as it affects the Joy and Martineau residences. No action was taken, but the councilmen were to talk to the resident owners and give them a permit to hook up with the existing sewer. Discussion was taken on bringing the matter of who owns the sewers to court.
