The Curry County Weed Control program for 1954 was announced this week by Kenneth Priest, county extension agent. According to his figures 4½ miles of city road was sprayed for Brookings in cooperation with Curry County at a cost to the City of \$266.50 and a cost to the county of \$297.00 and a total cost of \$560.00. The cost includes labor, equipment and materials.

County roads sprayed in this area includes six miles of the Winchuck River Road; 6½ miles
