

LETTER TO EDITOR

A recent item in the Pilot stated that the Curry County Citizens Committee voted to support Doane for County Judge. Third, neither is the idea that we are a neglected section of the county anything new.

Neither Doane nor Judge Forsyth is a resident of this area and they will not be after election.

I do not wish to say anything against Doane as I have not met him and have no way of knowing of his ability to handle such work. With this thought in mind I would be astonished to learn that your editorial was written before you had met our present county judge.
