

### To Show H-Bomb Film In Brookings

A color film of the world's first H-bomb explosion, "Operation Ivy", will be held Oct. 31, 7:30 p. m. at the Brookings Seventh Day Adventist church.

It will be a public showing and there is no charge, according to Pastor Calvin V. Hartnell.

The half-hour movie shows the detonation of "Mike" the H-bomb tested at Eniwetok Atoll in 1952. In the control room of the headquarters hip, a member of the scientific task group counts down the last 15 seconds to zero. In the final seconds, the camera switches to the "shot" island to record a tremendous fireball.

Photographs were taken from helicopters immediately following the blast. The audience is able to look down into a mile-in-diameter crater created by the explosion. About 14 Pentagon buildings could be accommodated in the crater.

"Any future war could strike first in the United States, and it would be total war—affecting even the smallest community", declare our Civil Defense directors. "This warning is implied in the film. After living in the atomic age for a decade, many individuals still do not realize the need for preparedness on the home front. That is why the U. S. government believed it was necessary to declassify this film and release it to the public."

For freedom sake, the public is urged to see this revealing picture.
