BOY IS KILLED IN HUNT ACCIDENT

Mr. and Mrs. Robert Maris were called to Medford, Ore., recently when their 12 year old grandson, Phillip S. Minear, son of Mr. and Mrs. Robt. Minear was wounded fatally and a girl friend of the

same age was shot through the arm by the same bullet from a 30-30 rifle by a hunter Saturday as the two were playing near the brush in the Merford area.

The two were rushed to the hospital where the boy died a few hours later. Funeral services were held on Tuesday, Oct. 19, from Medford Mortuary. Pall bearers were Boy Scouts.

Surviving are his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Robert Minear, the grandmother, Mrs. Minear, and two sisters, his maternal grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. Robert Maris, and great grandmother, Mrs. Agnes Maris of Smith River, and other relatives.
