One by four ceiling stripping is almost all in, a donation of the material by the Bron Lumber Co., on the Winchuck. Just as soon as the windows and doors are in, and the heat on so as to dry the building out thoroughly, ceiling tiles can be hung and the insulation batts stapled. These latter jobs can be easily handled by ladies, who can keep in touch with progress through Mrs. Erma Rice or Mrs. May (Earl) Sampson.

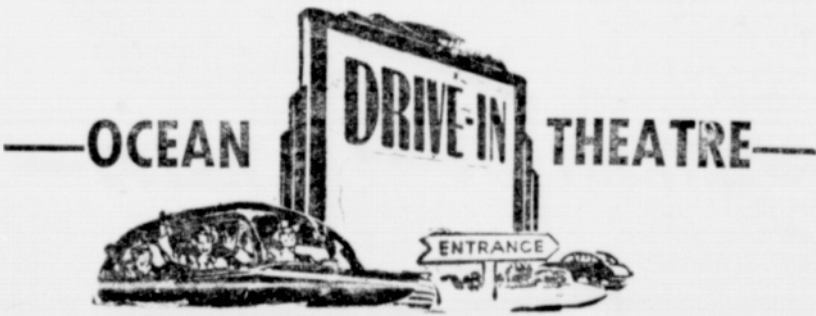
The Library Board is hoping to have their Nov. 29th, monthly meeting in the new building, regardless.

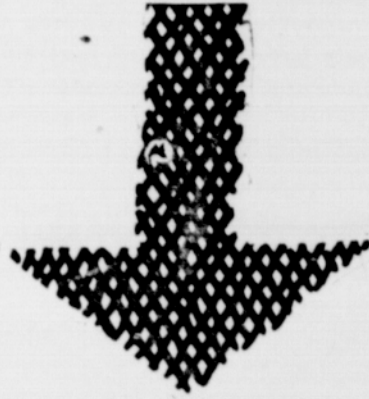
