missioner from the south end. This low water bridge was available only in the summer time and a large portion of the back country cut off from communication. In 1934 the forest service, in conjunction with the county, built four miles of road along the old railroad right of way, and this has since been developed, cooperatively, the forest service continuing the bridge, construction of which could not have been possible with county funds alone.

Commissioner J. R. Yoakum emphasized the improvement in transportation, citing his experiences, some 45 years ago, when he first came into the country buying cattle which were trailed out to Roseburg.

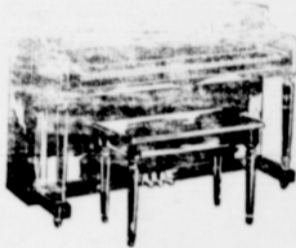
