Install New Phone Facilities In Area

Improved telephone facilities for Brookings and other Southwestern Oregon communities are now in effect, following installation of several new West Coast Telephone Company circuits during November.

District Manager George McBride announced the installation of new circuits from Reedsport, Bandon and Gold Beach to Coos Bay, from Bandon to Port Orford and from Powers to Myrtle Point.

Microwave Phone System Operating

The microwave radio system now operating between Coos Bay and Eugene has improved long distance telephone service considerably, according to George McBride, District Manager for the West Coast Telephone Company.

Following exhaustive tests the radio system was put into full operation this month, and will ultimately transmit as many as 45 telephone conversations simultaneously. Radio-telephone conversations are subject to less interference from storms than conversations carried by regular open wire facilities, said McBride.

In addition to the originating stations at Coos Bay and Eugene, there are microwave repeater stations located at intervals between those points.

The West Coast Telephone Co. also operates microwave radio-telephone systems between Crescent City and Eureka in Calif. and between Anacortes and Guemes Island in Washington.

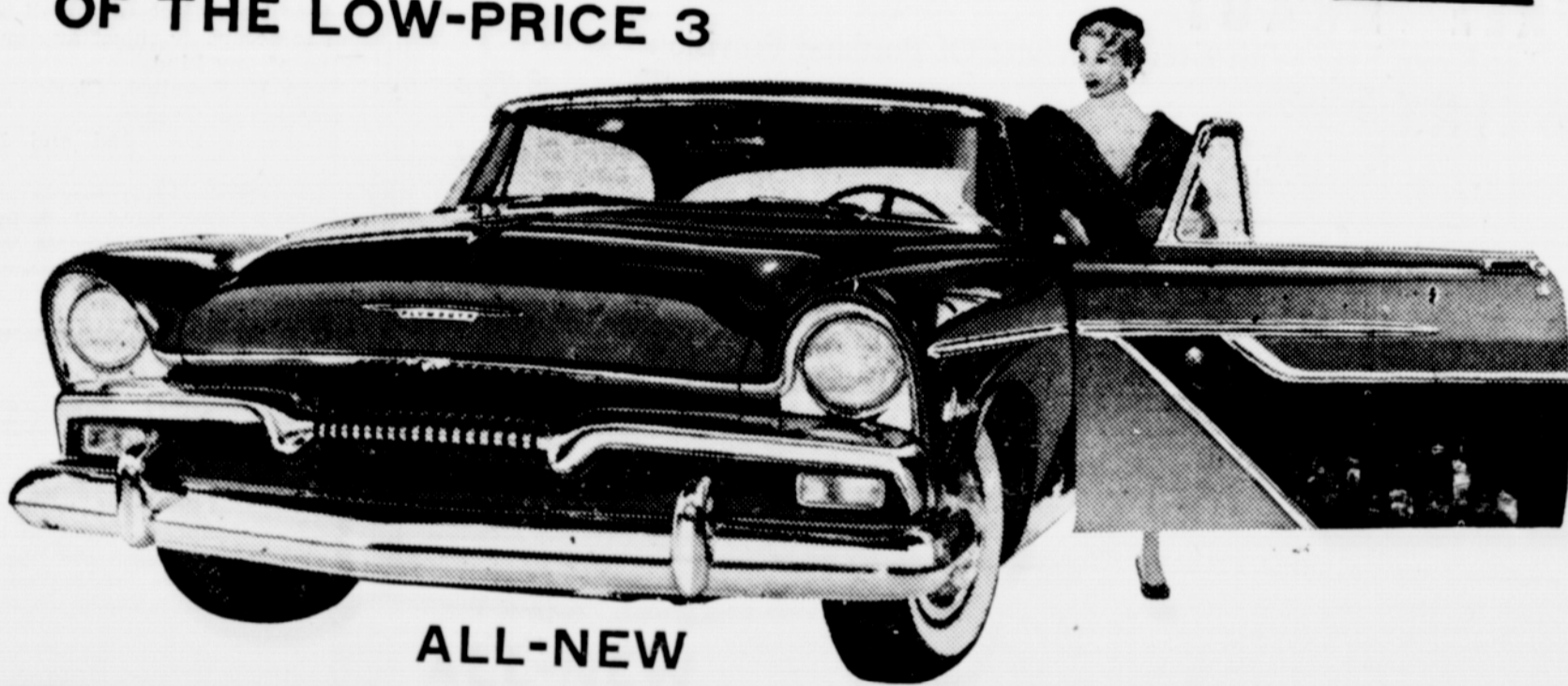

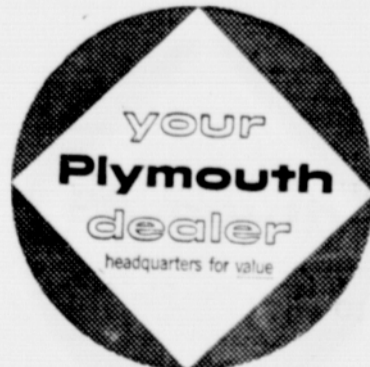
