## OREGON ELKS BUY EYE TESTER

The Oregon State Elks association has purchased a \$1200 machine for the eye department of the University of Oregon medical school in Portland which is revolutionizing the testing of side vision among visually handicapped children.

With this latest contribution, Oregon's 41 Elks lodges through their state association have spent approximately \$85,000 in support of the Children's Eye clinic at the medical school.

This new machine, manufactured in Switzerland and called the Goldman perimeter, is believed to be the only one in the West. The perimeter is so new that it still is considered in the experimental stage.

Testing of side vision no longer is much of a problem for the Children's Eye clinic because of the speedy, accurate perimeter, said Dr. John L. Bond, clinic director.

Side vision is one of two types of vision that a person has. The other is central vision. You use central vision, which is sharp vision, when you read, write, and look directly ahead, explained Dr. Bond. The eye chart is a common test of central vision.

Where central vision has a range than that. Side vision, al-vision has a field of 180 degrees and some persons have a wider range than that. Side vision, although not as sharp as central vision, is just as important when you begin moving about. Without side vision, you would bump into things when attempting to pass them and you would be blind at night.

The ability to see in lower illumination—or at night—is better from the side. Aircraft spotters depend more on their side vision because a tiny object in the night sky can be lost if stared at directly with the limited scope of central vision, said Dr. Bond.

One hundred years ago, doctors termed a loss of side vision as the "blind staggers," meaning that the

patient stumbled about, from side to side, bumping in objects, he related. Since then, the term has been corrupted to describe a drunk person.

Early detection of poor side vision followed by treatment or surgery may save a child from being prone to accidents. The afflicting disease usually are found in the eye, brain or optic nerve, which connects the eye to the brain.

The investigative work with the perimeter is under the direction of Dr. John Weissel, resident eye doctor at the medical school. He feels that one of the advantages of the perimeter is that it keeps a child from being distracted.

The child sits facing the interior of the large, bowl-shaped perimeter, with his head partly inside. His chin rests on a support and his head is strapped so he cannot move it. Watching through a one-way telescope tube in back of the perimeter, the doctor sees that the child's eyes are fixed on the center point inside the bowl. Red, green, blue and white lights, varying in size from a pinpoint to a dime, are projected on the inside of the perimeter and shifted from one side to the other by a mechanical arm operated by the doctor.

The arm is connected to a graph to chart the various paths of the lights. The doctor also can determine at what angle a child first sees a light as it sweeps from behind the youngster in the range of his side vision.

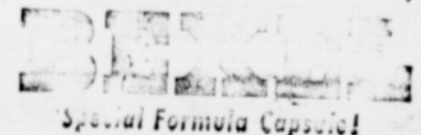
