The Brookings-Harbor high school basketball team lost their Saturday night game tussle with Port Orford by 11 points, 72 to 61. The loss ended a two game winning streak set up by the Bruins in their past games with the Illinois Valley quintet.

Ken Russell, the hot shot forward for the local aggregation netted 29 points to be high scorer for the evening. Ken gained this total on the strength of 10 field goals and 9 gift tosses. Frank Fadling dropped in 12 points to be second high man for the Bruins. Dan Montague was high man for the Port Orford team with 20

points to his credit.

The Pirates from the north gained a first quarter lead and kept it that way for the entire contest. The score at the end of the quarter was 26 to 17 in Ports favor.

The Bruins outscored the home team in the second stanza, but on the strength of the early lead the Pirates still held a margin at half time, 40 to 25. They continued to build that margin after intermission by outscoring the Bruins 17 to 11.
