County Welfare Curtails Aid Due To Lack of Funds

The Curry County Public Welfare Commission attacked the problem of insufficient funds in two categories of assistance, Aid to Dependent Children and General Assistance, by voting to curtail assistance in these two categories at its regular monthly meeting on Wednesday, February 2, in the Commission offices in the Medical Center Building.

General Assistance recipients in Curry County who are receiving grocery assistance by requisition will only receive one half the State standard allowance commencing February 1, as the result of the local Commission's Wednesday action. No aid to Dependent Children grants will be cut for the month of February, but payment of all ADC grants

for March will be delayed to permit local Commission staff members to make an accurate determination of the amount of money available for payment of ADC grants and thereafter ADC payments will be made up to the limit of the available money.

Both of the emergency actions followed a report by H. D. Olney, Administrator for the County Commission, on the rate of expenditure and current balances in both funds. Olney pointed out that in General Assistance more than \$900 of a \$1,500 allocation for the calendar quarter January 1 to March 31 had been spent during the month of January. It was also pointed out that no reply had been received from the State Public Welfare Commission to the local Commission's resolution, adopted at the January meeting, requesting that the State Commission restore a \$1,000 cut in ADC funds of the local Commission, which the State ordered in December.

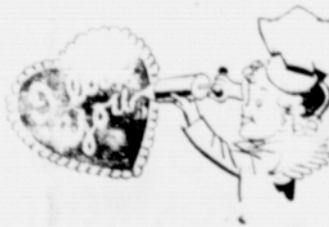
