WHEREAS, by authority granted in ORS 526.310 through ORS 526.360 the County Court of each County containing forest lands may, in its discretion, establish a forest land classification, and which after having established, has undertaken a preliminary classification and after proper investigation and study has been fit to set aside into Class I or Forest Lands, the following described areas in Curry County.

WHEREAS, as also required by law, said notices of public hearing shall be published for two (2) consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation in Curry County and be posted in three (3) public places within that County stating that the formal classification hearing for the setting aside as Class I, or Forest Lands, the following described lands in Curry County will be held at the Curry County Courthouse in Gold Beach, Oregon, at 10:00 o'clock in the morning of April 29, 1955, and to receive from any interested persons objections, remonstrances or suggestions relating to the proposed classification.
