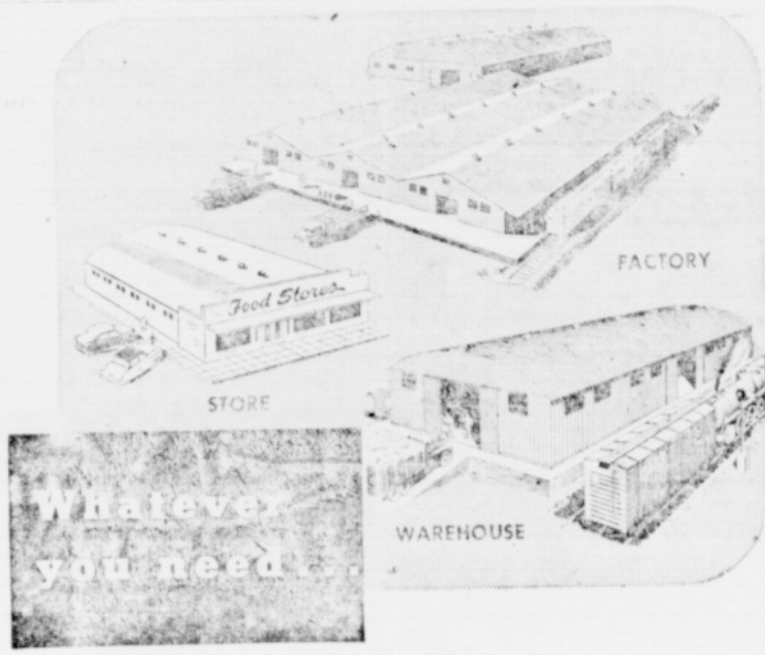


PLAN DANCE SATURDAY

WHEREAS, by authority granted in ORS 526.310 through ORS 526.330 the County Court of each County containing forest lands may, in its discretion, establish a forest land classification committee, and which after having established, and undertaken a preliminary classification and after proper investigation and study has been fit to set aside into Class 1 or Forest Lands, the following described areas in Curry County:
WHEREAS, as also required by law, said notices of public hearing shall be published for two (2) consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation in Curry County and be posted in three (3) public places within that County, stating that the formal classification hearing for the setting aside as Class 1, or Forest Lands, the following described lands in Curry County will be held at the Curry County Courthouse in Gold Beach, Oregon, at 10:00 o'clock

The area may be more particularly described as follows:

"All lands in Curry County excepting areas now classified as Class III or grazing land, as recorded and contained in Ordinance No. 20 (2) dated the second day of June 1954 and filed with the Curry County Recorder on the tenth day of January, 1955, in the Curry County Courthouse in Gold Beach, Oregon."
