Ray Western, 1954 graduate of Brookings High, is going down the right field spot on the Seattle Pacific College diamond squad. Western is following through with the All-Star form he showed while playing sandlot ball for the Blue and Gold Bruins last Spring.

Dale Parker, Seattle's Pacific coach, considers Western one of the top prospects on this year's Falcon team. In Seattle Pacific's three early games, Ray collected three doubles, one triple, and two singles in eleven times at bat. His defensive play in right field has been spotless.

Seattle's Pacific's starting nine this season is made up of five freshmen, two sophomores, and only one senior. The pitching staff is made up entirely of freshmen with the exception of two sophomores. Parker's face lights up when he speaks of future Falcon baseball teams.

The Falcons have beat the University of Washington in an early season game. Two losses to Seattle University were followed by the winning of a double header from Pacific Lutheran College. Fresh from the two wins over the Lutherans, Seattle Pacific tackles St. Martin's College this Friday at Seattle.

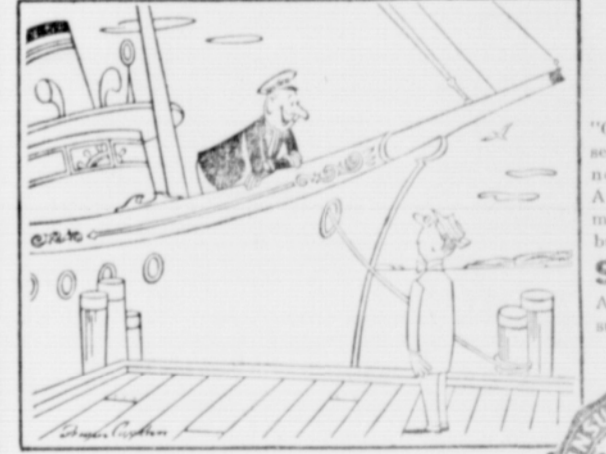
