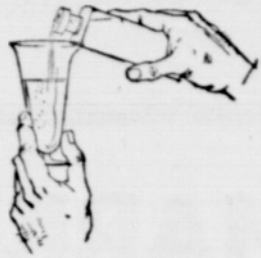

Home loan borrowers from the state of Oregon will soon be notified in regard to the mortgage insurance act of the last legislature, according to a recent news release from the state veterans bureau.

The plan is setup to cancel the balance due on a state veterans home loan mortgage should the veteran borrower pass away. Insurance companies are now submitting bids and as soon as these have been acted upon each borrower of record will be notified as to how much the loan will cost, the predicted rate being very low.

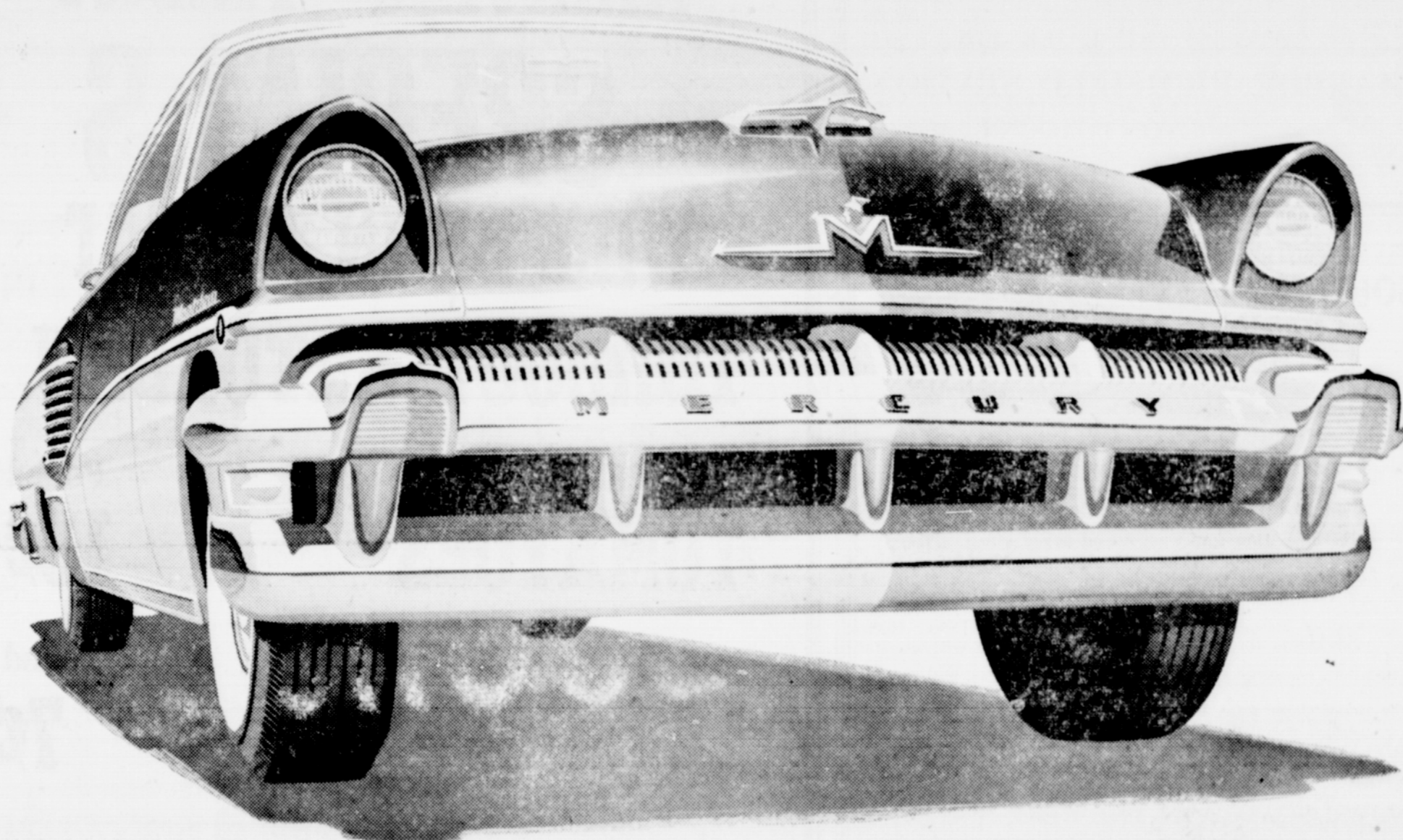

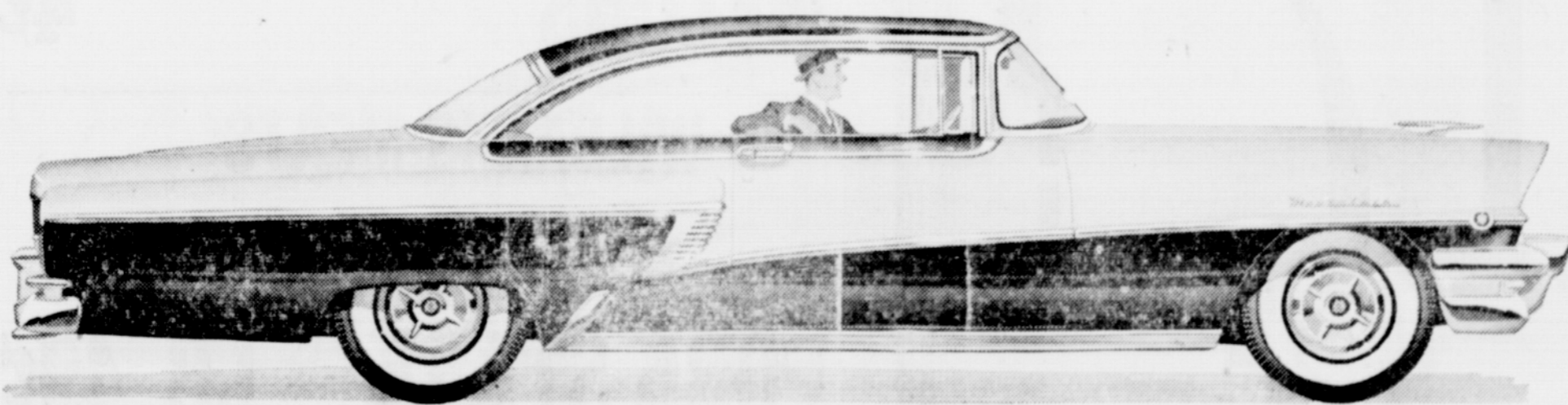
