Mr. and Mrs. Ted Freeman left, this last weekend, on an elk hunting trip to eastern Oregon.



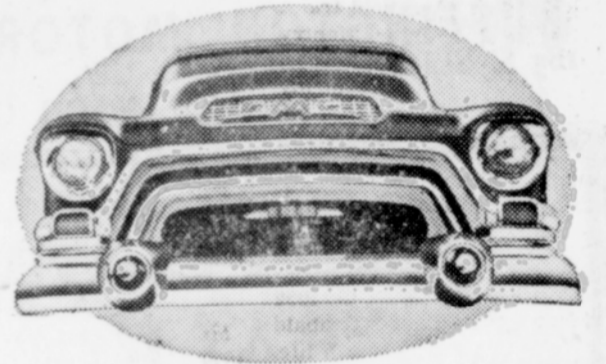
