SON KILLED IN CAR WRECK

The Horace Colberts, of Brookings, were saddened by the loss of their son, Delbert, and his family, in a car wreck near Grants Pass, last week.

According to a story in the Albany DEMOCRAT-HERALD, Delbert, 22, and his wife, Bonnie, 22 and their two children, Vickie, 2, and Douglas, 11 months, were in a car which skidded across the highway on a curve near Sexton Mountain, while enroute toward Crescent City, colliding with a car driven by Marvin R. Winemen, of Glendale, Oregon. The gas tank in the Colbert car is said to have exploded and the occupants succumbed.

Besides the parents, other Brookings survivors include a sister of Delbert's, Peggy, and a brother, Lendle.

Marketing Is Major Problem In Livestock

Thirty livestock producers heard David C. Shaw, President of the Curry County Livestock Association state that major problems facing the livestock producers today were marketing and livestock improvement.

Shaw made these statements at the annual meeting of the Curry County Livestock Association held at Gold Beach, on Friday, November 4, 1955.

Studies made by committees brought out the need for an additional government hunter to control predatory animals and a need for all livestock producers to become fully aware of the losses caused by parasites in cattle.

The marketing and taxation

committee recommended that increased slaughter facilities be encouraged to increase the use of lamb and beef by the home and store locker trade. Because of increased taxes this committee recommended that the Oregon State Extension Service make an economic study of Curry County to facilitate County planning to meet needs of school, roads and other tax loads. It was emphasized that tax payers should give greater attention to the County's budget making processes when the County Budget Committee holds their public hearings. It was pointed out that the tax bills in November were the result of all County budget hearings.
