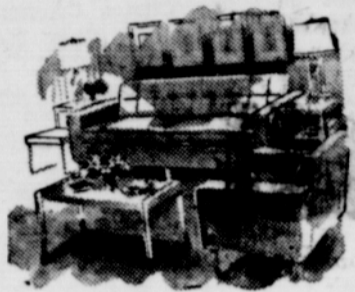

She is survived by her husband, C. J. Taylor and the family home is at 1611 1/2 F. Street, Sacramento; daughter, Mrs. Bertha Tichner and granddaughter, Jacquelyn Tichner, of West Sacramento.

James Brooking bought a ranch at Smith River in 1860 and soon after married Susan Lane. He built and ran the Brooking Hotel which was located by the old willow tree (which he planted) near the present site of the creamery, and which housed the first Smith River Post Office.
