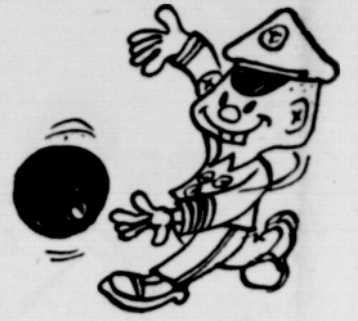

A lot of them would not survive if transplanted, he believes. Young trees already in the forests will be badly damaged by the freeze.
