STORM DAMAGES —
Storm damage in the North-
west's forests during November
and December 1955, amounted to
an estimated \$1,108,000, so far
as can be determined, considerably
less than the destruction
caused in 1948 when winter snow
was quickly melted by sudden
warm weather and heavy rains.
In a report sent out, it is stated
the above million dollars will
probably not replace all the
bridges and take care of other
repairs as some regions have not
yet been explored due to the
conditions. Of this sum, some
shudder as to what might happen
to their little folks, playing
on their own place.

\$42,000 or more may be needed
to replace forest camp and the
picnic areas.
In the whole Northwest Region,
Siskiyou Forest, with headquarters
in Grants Pass, suffered the
heaviest with the Mt. Hood
Forest next in losses. Nearly
every forest in the region suffered
some loss. Temporary repairs
have been made in some places
but in others the work may
not be completed until '57.
The greatest losses were said
to be bridges washed out on the
Sisyou and Okanogan Forests.
It will be some time before all
the damage is known as some of
the trails and roads are still
covered with snow.

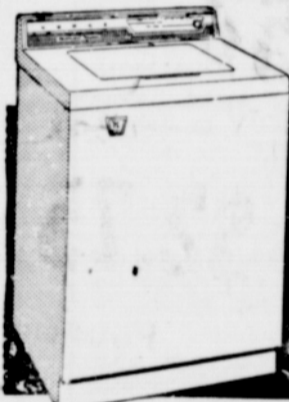

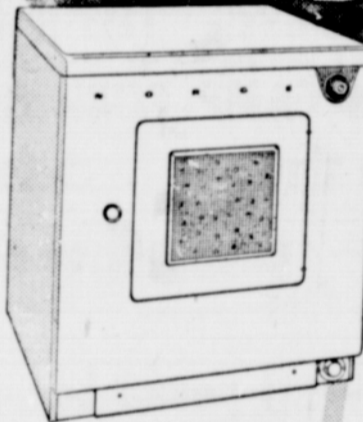

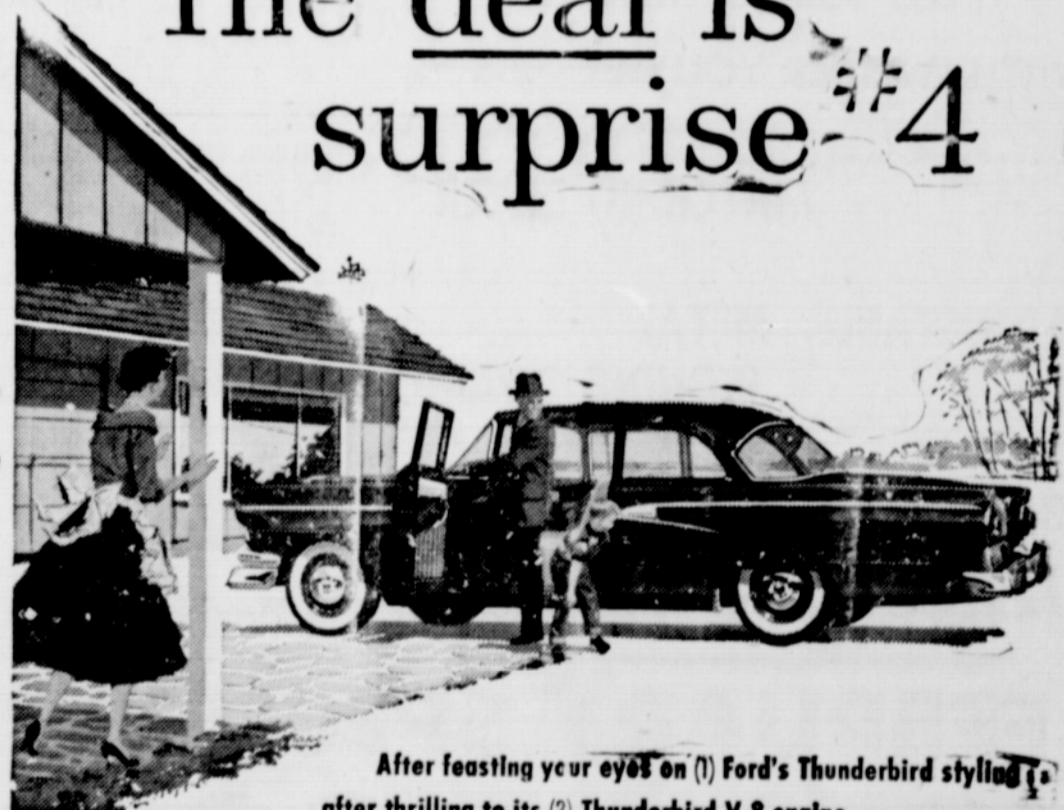
