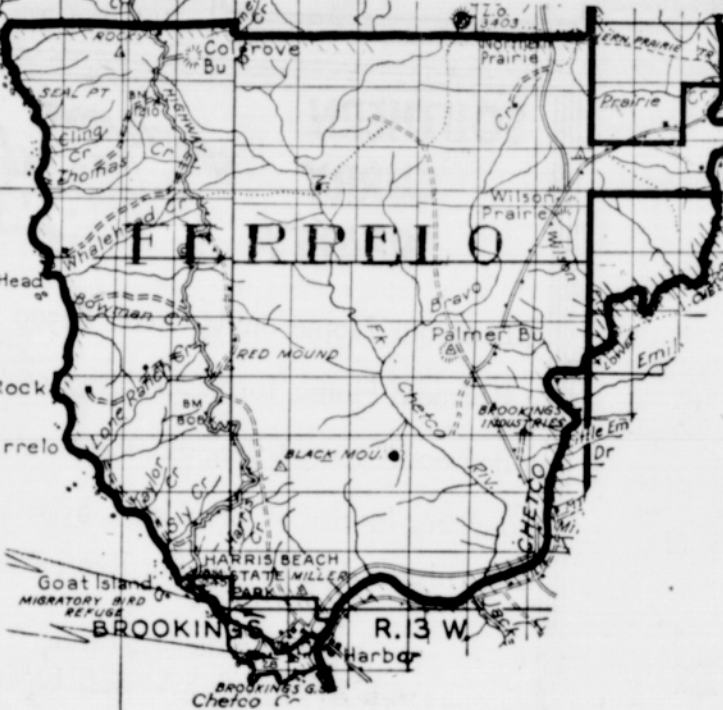
— VOTERS NOTICE —

The City of Brookings has been divided in two Precincts with Highway 101 as the dividing line as follows:

BROOKINGS PRECINCT NO. 1 —
 All residents on the oceanside of Highway 101 and between the Chetco River and the city limit boundary on the North of Brookings.

BROOKINGS PRECINCT NO. 2 —
 All residents on the Easterly side of Highway 101 and between the Chetco River and city limit boundary on the North of Brookings.

FERRELO PRECINCT —
 All residents not residing within the city limits of Brookings and North of the Chetco River. (See Map)



The registered voters residing in these Precincts should notify Oleta A. Walker, County Clerk, Gold Beach at once, stating their precinct, so their names will be listed in the proper poll book.

If not registered, you can register with Mrs. Mae Smith, City Recorder of Brookings and official Registrar for these Precincts or at the County Clerk's office in Gold Beach.

PLAN TO LET BID ON COURT HOUSE

Bids on the County Court House will be opened at 8 p.m. on February 24th, by the Curry County Court. Drawings and the specifications of the project are available through the Architect Raymond O. Marks.
 The new building will be 66' by 114', and will be two stories, with a full basement. Plans show the County Agent, Welfare, Visiting Nurse and Jail will be in the basement, with the county clerk's office, county judge, the county court, Assessor's, Sheriff's office, tax collection office, treasurer and state police on the ground floor. The school superintendents office, county surveyor, district attorney, law library, circuit judges chamber and jury room will be on the second floor. The building will have an elevator.

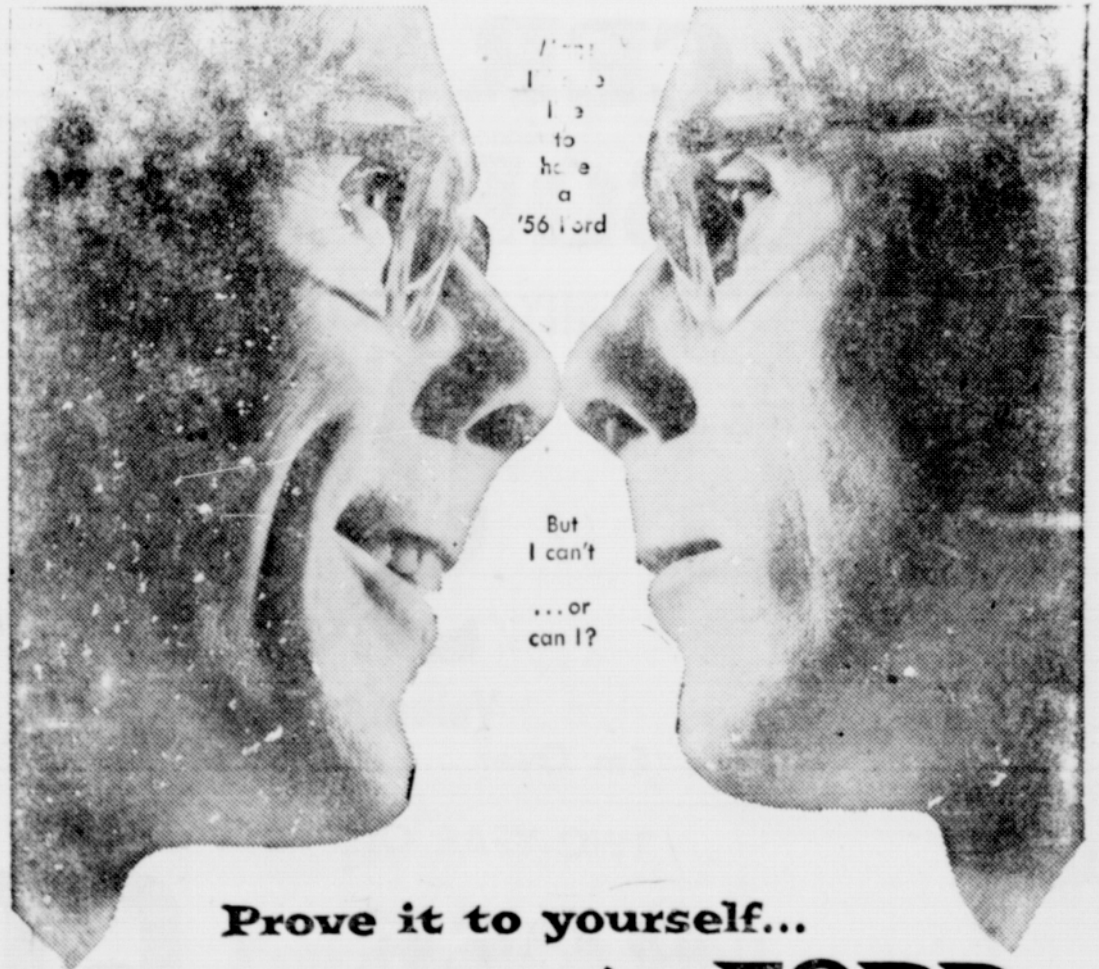
