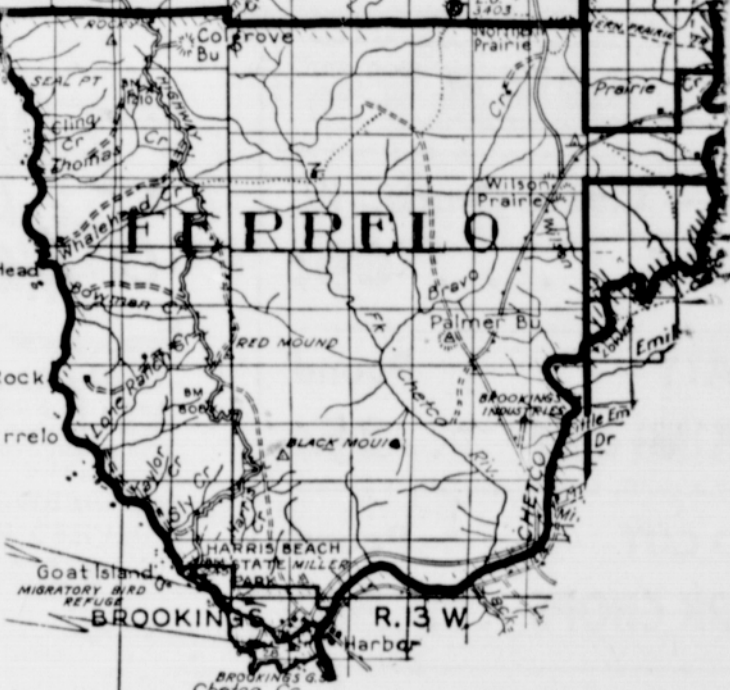
VOTERS NOTICE

All residents on the Easterly side of Highway 101 and be-
tween the Chetco River and city limit boundary on the
North of Brookings.

FERRELO PRECINCT —
All residents not residing within the city limits of Brookings

Precincts or at the County Clerk's office in Gold Beach.

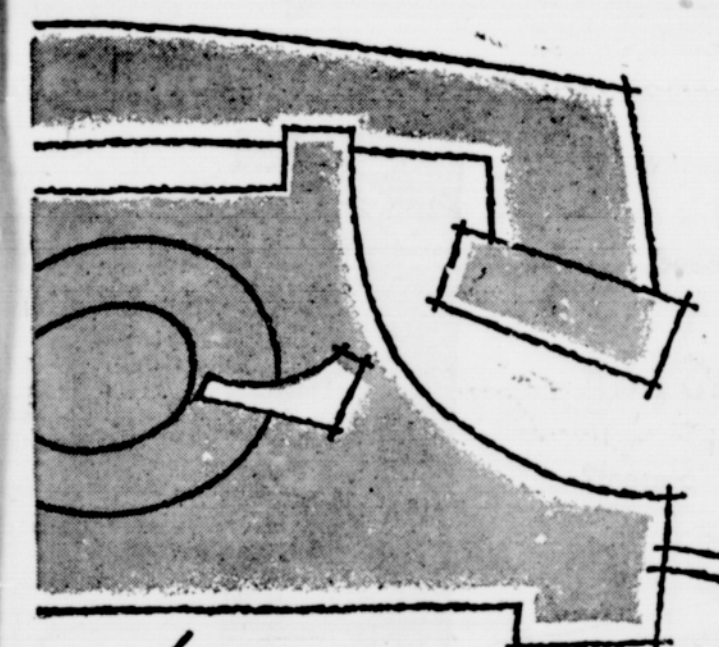

OREGON STATE ELKS SUPPORT EYE CLINIC

Retrolental fibroplasia, the
tongue-twisting eye disease that
not long ago blinded a high per-
centage of premature babies, is
continuing to decline in Oregon.
The children's eye clinic at the

University of Oregon medical
school show only four 'preemies'
with retrolental fibroplasia
(RLF) in 1955—and three of
these cases were mild ones.

About two years ago, re-
searchers pinned the cause on
too much oxygen being given to
preemies in incubators. The
children's eye clinic was among
the first to advance this solution.

Dr. Kenneth Swan, head of
the clinic and the school's eye
department, said more accurate
control of oxygen has reduced
the RLF toll in Oregon, but he
warned that the disease has not
been eliminated entirely.

The four cases of RLF last
year were diagnosed by the
clinic from among 32 preemies.
This rate of 12.5 percent com-
pares with 18 percent in 1954
and 78 percent in 1951.

The clinic, which is sup-
ported financially by the Oregon State
Elks Association to care for
underprivileged youngsters, also
reported giving 3227 treatments
to Oregon children in 1955. This
makes a total of 27,571 treat-
ments given to 4919 children
since the clinic was set up in
1949.
