LAMBS' WOOL

A news release put out by the Oregon State College states, in substance, that provision has now been made whereby the growers of feeder lambs will share directly in wool incentive payments. Under the old program, only the seller of fat lambs got the bonus. The original owner is now eligible for a payment based on the full live weight of the lamb at the time he sells it and each subsequent owner will be eligible for payment only on that part of the weight produced during his ownership of at least 30 days.
Incentive payments for lamb wool will be based on the national average of wool—five pounds per hundred weight of the animal.

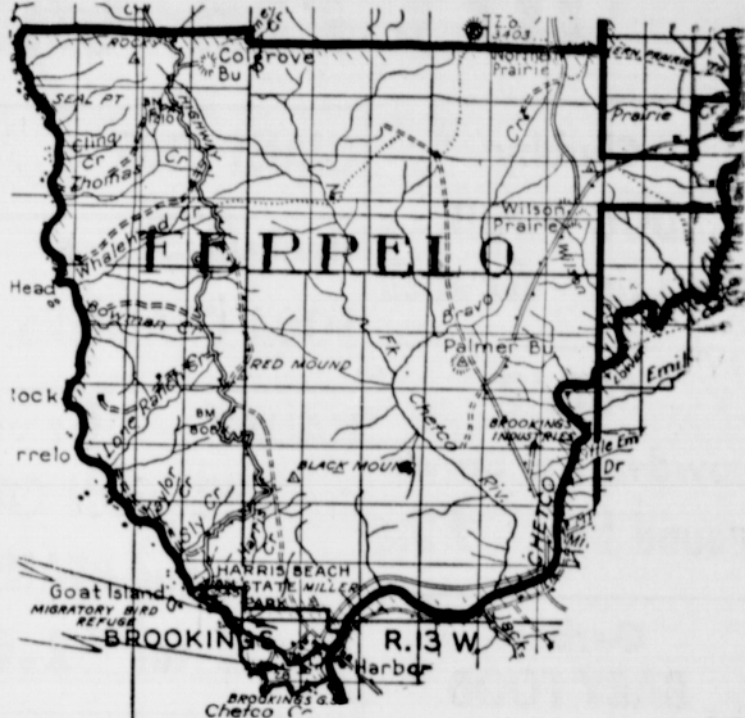
VOTERS NOTICE

GAME LICENSES — There was a slight increase in the number of hunting and fishing licenses of all types, during the past year, although the figures for '55 were but 98 percent complete. The tally for '54 was 483,522 while for '55 it has added so far, 498,074. Increases were shown in almost all categories but there was a noticeable falling off in the non-resident anglers licenses but an increase in the vacation angler status from 24,979 to 25,620, which indicates the popularity of this type among our visitors.
