According to releases by the country's top Jersey authorities Sweet's 4 year, 4 months old heifer, Sparkling Dandy Spozza gave out with 11,476 pounds of milk, floating 697 pounds of butterfat in 305 days. Sparkling Sir Topsy produced 12,365 pound of milk containing 658 pounds of butterfat in the same time, at the age of 2 years and 11 months and Tristram Basil Pride trailed with 11,407 pounds of milk, skimming 617 pounds of butterfat over the same period, when a month less than four years old. Sweet has several other bovines which added either a Gold or a Silver medal certificate to their record.

CURRY COUNTY TO GET ROAD WORK

At its next regular meeting in Portland, on March 1st, the State Highway Department will receive bids for reconstruction of two sections of the Oregon Coast Highway recently destroyed by heavy rainfall and storm. The two sections of roadway to be rebuilt are located about 12 miles south of Port Orford in the vicinity of Mussel Creek. Plans call for excavation of the roadbed foundation to provide a firm base, provision of additional drainage facilities and the reconstruction of the roadbed with rock materials. The work is scheduled for completion by the middle of July.
