

Rogue Area may be Park

The proposed withdrawal of 7,870.67 acres of public land inside the Siskiyou National Forest along the Rogue River for recreational purposes was announced today by Virgil Heath, Supervisor of the Bureau of Land Management for Oregon. An application has been filed by the Secretary of Agriculture to withdraw the lands. The application was recorded on public land records in the Land Office at Portland on August 5, 1955.

Mr. and Mrs. Fullerton, from Effect of the recordation temporarily bans prospecting and the location of mining claims under the general mining laws in the affected areas pending action by the Department of Interior.

A 30-day waiting period is provided during which written comments or objections may be submitted by the public. Heath said that the lands proposed for withdrawal are in a strip approximately one-half mile wide on each side of the Rogue, beginning near Whitenack Camp at the mouth of Whiskey Creek and extending by generally even numbered sections to a point approximately eight air-line miles west of Agness, or a total river distance of approximately 40 miles. The area has a high recreational and scenic value and the proposed withdrawal would protect these values for the use of the general public against the staking of any claims or entries which might be incompatible with recreation activities. However, the language of the withdrawal states that all valid existing rights will be honored. Most of the public lands in the strip are in power site reservations made during 1926 and 1928.

A detailed description of the public lands involved in the proposed withdrawal will appear shortly in the Federal Register and will be posted in the Land Office at Portland, Oregon, and at District Foresters' Offices at Coos Bay and Medford, Oregon. The land proposed for withdrawal is under the supervision of the Forest Supervisor, Siskiyou National Forest at Grants Pass, Oregon.
