Crescent City recently counted municipal noses and came up with 1,709 vs. Brookings 3,000 and some. Probably scantier acreage in the Del Norte county seat.

Del Norte county collected \$327.17 in trailer coach license fees which is divided between Crescent City and the various school districts, determined by the address of the trailer.

The Cave Junction Saddle Bums are planning a trip, for early in April, to the little Chetco River and from there on down the Illinois to Agness, according to a decision made at their last meeting. On March 29 they will continue plans when they gather at the home of Peggy Fulk, on Bolan Lake Road.

Planes from Cave Junction are seeding some 6,000 acres in Lake County. The seeding includes about half and half orchard grass and timothy at six pounds per acre. Most of it is done in burns of the Fremont National Forest in the Dry Prairie, Deming Creek, Round Butte and Summer Lake Rim country.

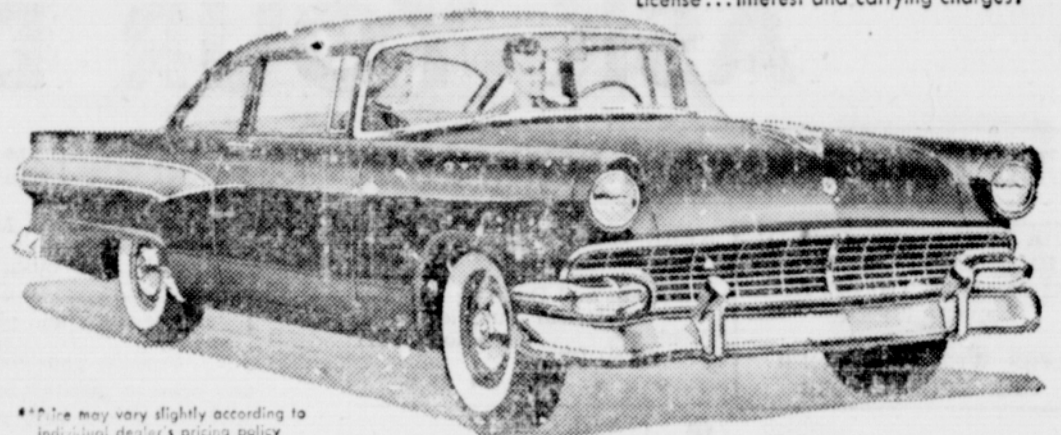

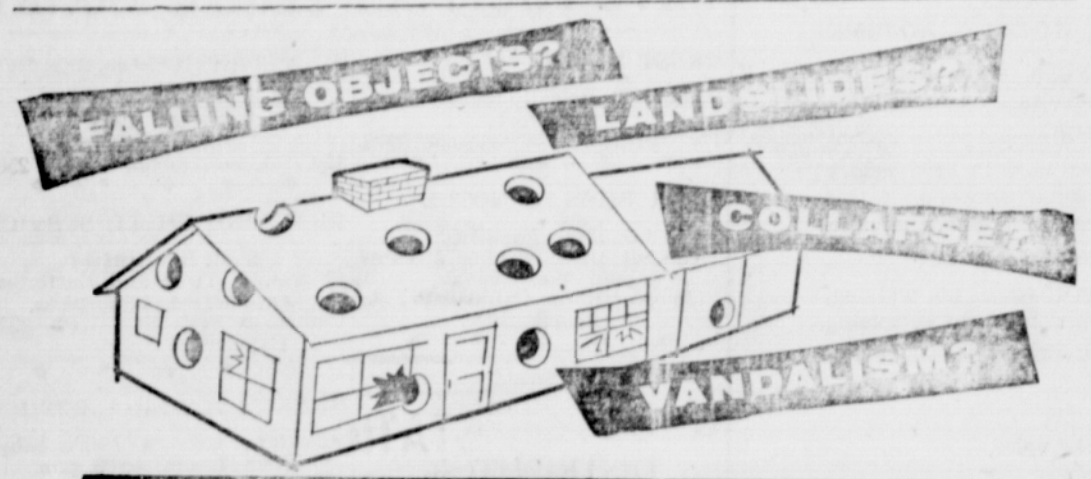
