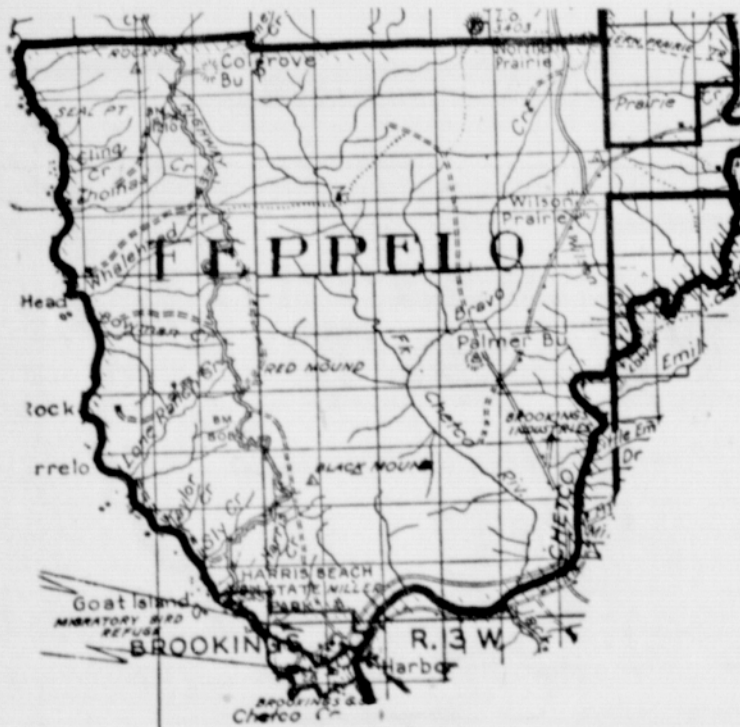
VOTERS NOTICE

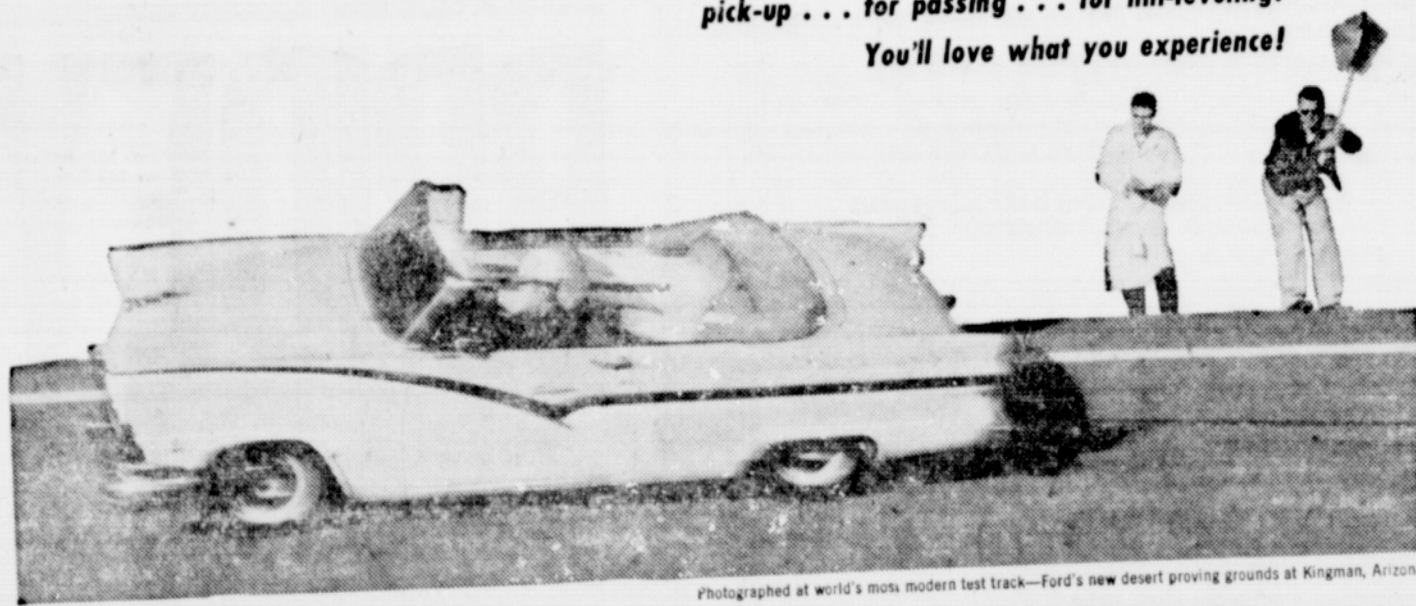
Pioneer Has Birthday
