Woodrich Takes Curry County Court Session

Circuit Judge Charles Woodrich is in Gold Beach this week to conduct the opening week of the Curry County jury term. Judge Woodrich resides in Roseburg, but is a member of the 2nd Judicial District which includes Curry, Coos, Douglas and Lane counties.

The late Governor Paul Patterson appointed Judge Woodrich to fill the second circuit judgeship in Douglas County created by the 1955 legislature. He was recommended for the appointment on the non-partisan judiciary ballot in all four counties in the May 18th primary election. He is a veteran of World War II, married and has two children.

Judge Woodrich is a member of the Circuit Judges Association the Oregon Judicial Council, the American Legion, Kiwanis, the B.P.O.E., Air Force Reserve and the American Judicature Society. In addition to his other circuit court duties he has been conducting the Juvenile Court in Douglas County. In that capacity he has negotiated for a survey of the juvenile court facilities to be performed by the National Parole and Probation Association. He has asked that specific attention in the survey be directed to his proposals for joint use of a detention facility by Lane and Douglas Counties, establishment of a CCC type disciplinary work camp for juvenile delinquents, and a foster home program for teen-age delinquents.

Since his appointment Judge Woodrich has held court in Coos, Lane and Douglas counties as well as a three-week assignment to Multnomah county.

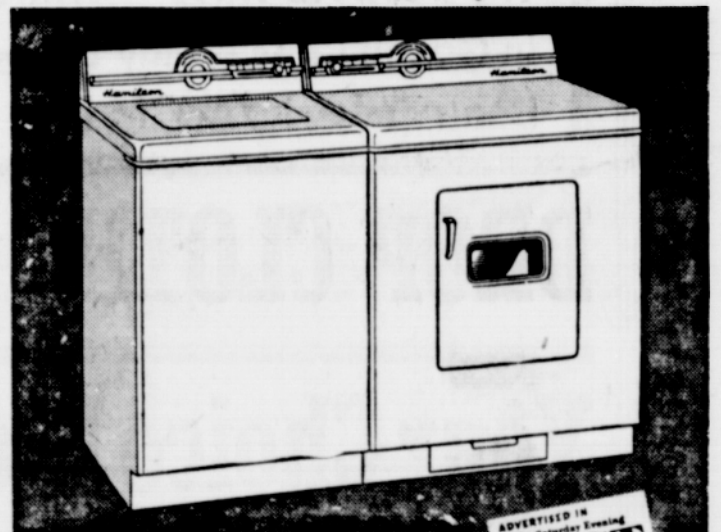

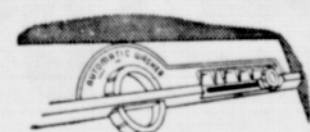
