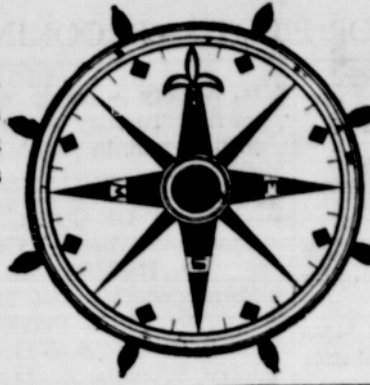

HIGHWAY SIGNS

Some 2,000 warnings have already been issued for violation of the new highway sign law, according to a Salem release. This new law makes liable for prosecution all unlicensed signs except those within 300 feet of the business advertised, unless a permit has been obtained.

3,150 permits have been issued for signs owned by sign companies and only 1,060 for those owned by individuals. Permit fees range from 50 cents to \$3.00, based upon the size of the signs.

The release states that there is now no excuse for those responsible not having obtained their permits or removed offending signs.
