

Curry Co. to have Mass X-Ray Survey

August 14 through August 20 has been set as the time for the mass chest x-ray survey in the county, according to the three sponsoring agencies, the Curry County Medical Society, the Curry County Public Health Department, and the Curry County Tuberculosis and Health Association.

Mrs. George Barnhart, a member of the Board of the Tuberculosis and Health Association, Mrs. Dorothea Miller, Public Health Nurse, Mrs. Francis Reiersen, Director of Health Education for the state, Mr. Kenneth Broyles, Senior X-Ray Technician for the State Board of Health, and Miss

Ruth McClun, Field Representative for the Oregon Tuberculosis and Health Association met in the Public Health office Thursday afternoon to set the time and to work out some of the phases of the survey.

Floyd Huffman, 65, widely known Del Norte citizen and business man, passed away suddenly Monday morning, July 30. He was the oldest son of the late Andrew and Nora Huffman and was born at Coos Bay, Feb. 22, 1891, coming with his parents, to Smith River when he was a year old, and spent much of his younger life there.

He formerly owned the Huffman Clothing store in Crescent City and later purchased the Antlers Cafe, which he operated at the time of his death. He was a member of Crescent Lodge, A. F. & A. M., Eureka Elks Lodge, and was the first commander of the Del Norte American Legion post.

Survivors are two daughters and two sons, Irene Huffman, Mrs. Ellen Louise Brundin, Charles and Nathan Huffman, all of Crescent City; three brothers, Austin, Edgar, and Jack Huffman, of Crescent City; nine grandchildren; an aunt, Mrs. Stella Elliott, and a number of cousins in both California and in Oregon.

Funeral services were held on Wednesday, Aug. 1, at 2 p.m. the Wiers' Mortuary Chapel, with graveside services by the Masonic Lodge and interment in the Smith River cemetery.
