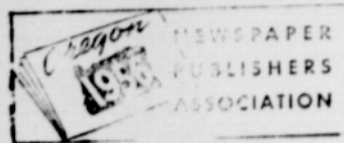

FALLACY 12. That some woods "breed" bedbugs and cockroaches; meaning, perhaps that some woods favor the development of such vermin within their cracks and crannies.

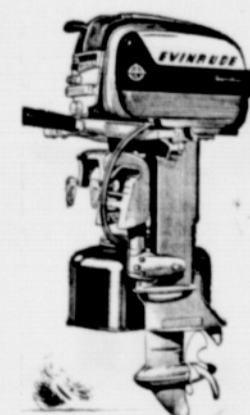
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
