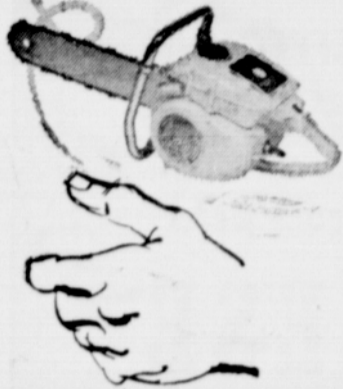

AN OPEN LETTER TO GEORGE SUTTON

Dear Mr. Sutton:

We, an interested group of Curry county taxpayers, composing the Mincer for Assessor committee, would like to ask you the following questions:

According to your campaign cards, you are representing yourself as the "Republican and Democratic Nominee for County Assessor." Let's face the facts: Isn't it the truth that NEITHER party has actively endorsed your candidacy? Although you are a registered Republican, hasn't your own county Central Committee failed to endorse you?

You cite your "active . . . cooperation" in the property reappraisal program. Wouldn't it be more accurate to call it "INACTIVE cooperation?" Why, when the reappraisal program was voted in 1952, has it taken you more than four years to get the program under way? Why was the contract with the state held up for almost TWO YEARS before it was signed? Why was this county allowed to drop from fourth to 14th on the list of counties on the state reappraisal schedule?

If you were actively seeking re-election, Mr. Sutton, why didn't you file in the primaries for re-election? Was it lack of interest, or lack of energy?

According to the summary of the assessment rolls for 1956, recently issued by your office, the total assessed valuation of the county has about exactly doubled in the last 10 years. During that same period, the assessed valuation of timber lands in the county has increased only about one million dollars. How many millions of dollars worth of timber have been cut off those lands in the last 10 years? How many tax dollars were collected on that timber? Do you feel that the taxpayers of the county are being treated on a fair and equitable basis?
