Schools for A Strong America

From the beginning of our democratic experiment thoughtful men saw the importance of education for the preservation of our liberties. The American people believe that education is a necessity, not a luxury. They believe that a strong nation cannot be built upon a weak foundation, and they believe that the schools help to build that strong foundation.

It is difficult to specify the sources of a nation's strength; but the Nations citizens, especially in

a democracy worthy of the freedoms of a democracy and capable of its responsibilities has always been the goal of our school. To date, this monumental task has been performed quite successfully.

By providing education for practically every American child, the school has given a common background to diverse economic, social and racial groups. It has helped to make one nation of a vast geographical area populated by widely different people. At the same time, universal free education has made it possible for individual, regardless of his background, to cultivate his particular talents and interests. Public school

have sent competent leaders into all walks of life.

The schools have helped all American Youth to acquire the habit, attitudes and experiences necessary to participate in the activities of their communities and their nation. Children participate in self government in their classrooms and in the school. They work together on common problems. They learn to respect the right of every other individual in the group. Experiences in the meaning and methods of democracy begin early and continue thru the child's whole school life.

Another task of the school is to produce healthy, skilled workers who can take their places in the economy with the most beneficial results to themselves and to the economic well being of the Nation. Our industrial society has made it possible for us to enjoy standards of living superior to those of any other people.

Education is an investment in citizens, in people. In spite of the increasing demands made upon them, the school have continued to make important contributions to the nation, but they must have more support to meet the crises facing them. Shortages in buildings and teachers continue to deprive nearly 900,000 pupils nationally of full-time schooling. Locally the school district is short 15 class rooms and 465 pupils are on half day sessions. So many adults citizens of the future cannot be deprived of full educational benefits with serious consequences to the community and to the nation.

American Education Week was set up to inform the public of the many accomplishments of the public schools. Good schools require the thoughtful support of every citizen. They also cost money but the returns in a better trained and informed youth are worth many times the investment. Won't you take time from your busy days to visit your schools during National Education Week? The Administration and teaching staff would like to meet you.
